Section 4.15

1. It shall be the policies of this department to give and ask for aid from any department that request or need department help based on the individual incident.
2. The following fire departments have written agreements on file with the Coldsprings Excelsior Fire and Rescue and shall provide manpower, apparatus or department assistance.
 - a. Kalkaska EMS
 - b. Kalkaska DNR
 - c. Kalkaska Township
 - d. Kalkaska Bear lake Township
 - e. Grand Traverse County Battalion 6
 - f. Fredrick Township Grayling Michigan
3. RECEIVING MUTUAL AID
 - a. The officer in charge shall ask for mutual aid when needed and advise of the staging area for incoming units and manpower.
4. GIVING MUTUAL AID
 - a. It will be the decision of the IC officer on scene on what equipment is necessary
 - b. To on scene officer shall be responsibal for assigning the staging area for our units to respond
 - c. Our incoming units should make contact with IC on fire ground 1 unless otherwise instructed to use another channel

- d. Our units will perform the requested task as long as it does not place out firefighters or equipment in undue risk
- e. Our units shall not leave the scene until instructed to do so by the command officer or our highest ranking department officer
